Course Title: AP UNITED STATES HISTORY	
Course Number: 1727	
Course Description: The Advanced Placement United States History Course focuses on developing students' understanding of American History from approximately 1491 to the present. The course has students investigate the content of US History for significant events, individuals, developments, and processes in nine historical periods, and develop and use the same thinking skills and methods (analyzing primary and secondary resources, making historical comparisons, chronological reasoning and argumentation) employed by historians when they study the past. The course also provides seven themes (American and national identity; migration and settlement; politics and power; work, exchange and technology; America in the world; geography and the environment; and culture and society) that students explore throughout the course in order to make connections among historical developments in different times and places.
